- Attendance expectations return and you are committing to a remote learning experience.
 - At minimum, students will be required to connect on a daily basis via a daily check-in or attendance statement. This may be completed through See Saw (Pre-K to Grade 2) or Schoology (Grades 3-5). We believe there is a difference between attendance and engagement/participation so there will be multiple ways to support daily attendance.
- **Grading** resumes and assessments and summative opportunities to assess learning will occur in accordance with our district assessment calendar. Families can expect weekly expectations posted at a designated time as determined by teacher.
- All students K-12 will receive **iPads**. CLEVER will remain as the "home base" for the housing of district utilized apps and learning platforms. Students are familiar with CLEVER and its accessibility, as this is used in school as well.
- Daily Learning is focused around standards-based instruction and high-quality instructional materials. A balanced schedule that accounts for developmentally appropriate screen time will be developed. Not all screen time is created equal. Times may vary and tasks may vary. Daily schedules will include live, synchronous, learning as well as asynchronous, self-paced learning.
- · Office hours will be scheduled on a daily basis, which will provide real time learning support.
